- Applications for and services of Idaho Legal Aid

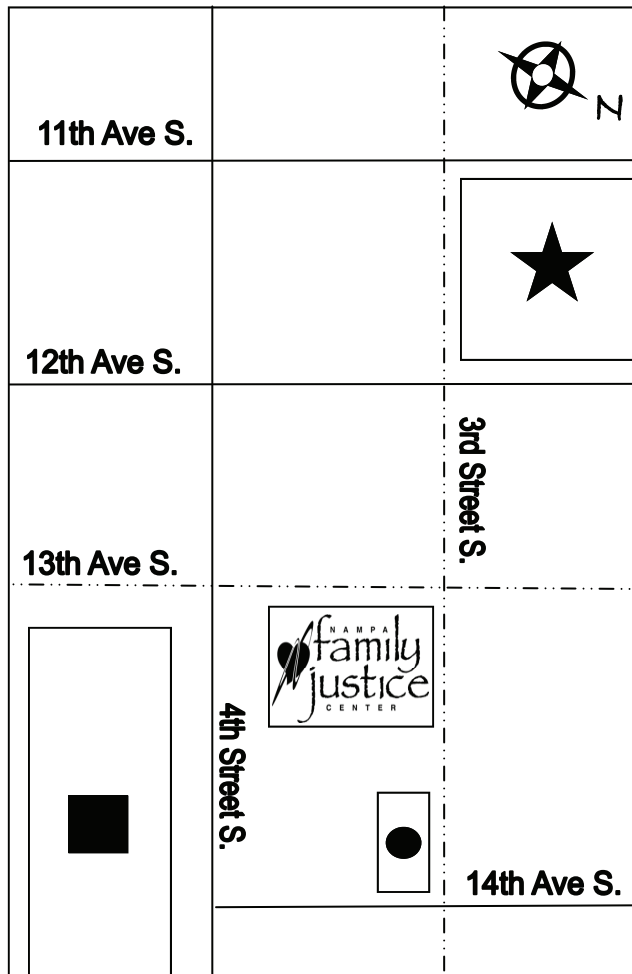
All services offered at the Family Justice Center are free of charge.

ABOUT YOUR VISIT WITH US

Everyone who visits can sit down one-on-one with an experienced advocate who will serve as your guide to getting the help you and your children need.

We want you to know that when you visit you can expect a very warm and comfortable place. You will also see that your safety is our top priority. Our building was specifically designed around keeping you (and your children) safe—from bulletproof glass at the entrance to on-site security that includes cameras and controlled access. Additionally, we keep everything you tell us in the strictest confidence, and don't share your information with anyone without your permission.

We know that often times your children have already heard more than you want them to. We want you to feel comfortable talking openly with us, so we have a fun playroom full of toys that is available for your children to keep them entertained during your visit at the Family Justice Center.

If you are fleeing an abusive situation, OR are thinking about it...

you may want to take a few of the following items (or all) if possible.

- Money, checkbook, bankbooks, credit cards, etc.
- Identification – Driver's license, Social Security cards, passport, green card, welfare ID, work permit, etc.
- Civil Protection Order
- Divorce and/or custody papers
- Birth certificates (yours and the childrens), school records, medical records, etc.
- Clothing for you and your children
- Lease, rental agreement, house deed, insurance papers (house, life, car, etc.)
- Keys – House, car, office, safe deposit box, etc.
- Medications (yours and the childrens)
- Address book
- Recent photos of your abuser and your house
- Copies of the last two years' tax returns (both yours and your partner's if you file separately)
